 - Bring your own cooler with drinks, grill available if you want to bring something to cook, also would be nice if people bring a snack or a sweet to share
 - We need a couple people to bring ironing boards, irons, and an extension cord
 - We’ll figure out Sunday what other supplies we need and send a few people to Home Depot to get them
 - Team Competitions – We signed up for remaining events – Volleyball, Scavenger Hunt, Putt-Putt golf, Jesse Burke will be our 4th dunk tank participant
 - Hospitality Room – our members voted to pay for a hospitality room at the Castle in the Sand (\$516.05)
 - It’ll be located in the Waverly Castle building, a large oceanfront room with a kitchenette & balcony, it’s located in the same area as many other Ravens Roosts’ hospitality suites
 - We’ll use this room to hold everyone’s coolers and drinks (label and bring your own), we will also store our parade costumes and decorations there
 - We’d like each member to bring a snack or sweet to share
 - Our hospitality room is to be used by Roost 102 members ONLY
 - Please do not keep any personal or valuable items in the hospitality room
 - NO ONE under 21 yrs old is to be in the room without a parent accompanying them – this is imperative because of the alcohol that we’ll have in the room and for the kids’ own safety
 - Roost 102 officers and board members will have keys to the Hospitality Room – any members wishing to use it need to get a key from us – the room must be kept locked at all times!!
 - If there’s any extra \$ leftover after we purchase supplies for the parade (from the \$10 we collect) we will use that\$ to purchase ice to refill the coolers in the room
